



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2017-18

Associate of Science in Natural Science (ASNS) Scholarship at Hawai'i Community College - Pālanuanui

Deadline: Thursday, June 1, 2017

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide assistance to students pursuing an Associate of Science degree in Natural Science at Hawai'i Community College - Pālanuanui. Funds shall be used to assist with any expenses related to cost of attendance (e.g. tuition, books, fees, etc.).

Award Amount: \$3,000 per year, for a total of \$6,000 over two years

Criteria:

1. Must be an undergraduate enrolled at full-time status at Hawai'i Community College - Pālanuanui pursuing an AS degree in Natural Science.
2. Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and/or place into MATH 135 and ENG 100.
3. Must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and included Hawai'i Community College in their list of institutions.
4. Must reside, or intend to reside, in West Hawai'i Island during the two years of ASNS studies.

Eligibility:

Recipients must always be making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and must progress toward completing their ASNS degree in two years. Recipients must also participate in STEM study groups and other co-curricular learning activities each semester.

Required documents:

1. Application form.
2. Short personal statement expressing interest and addressing criteria.
