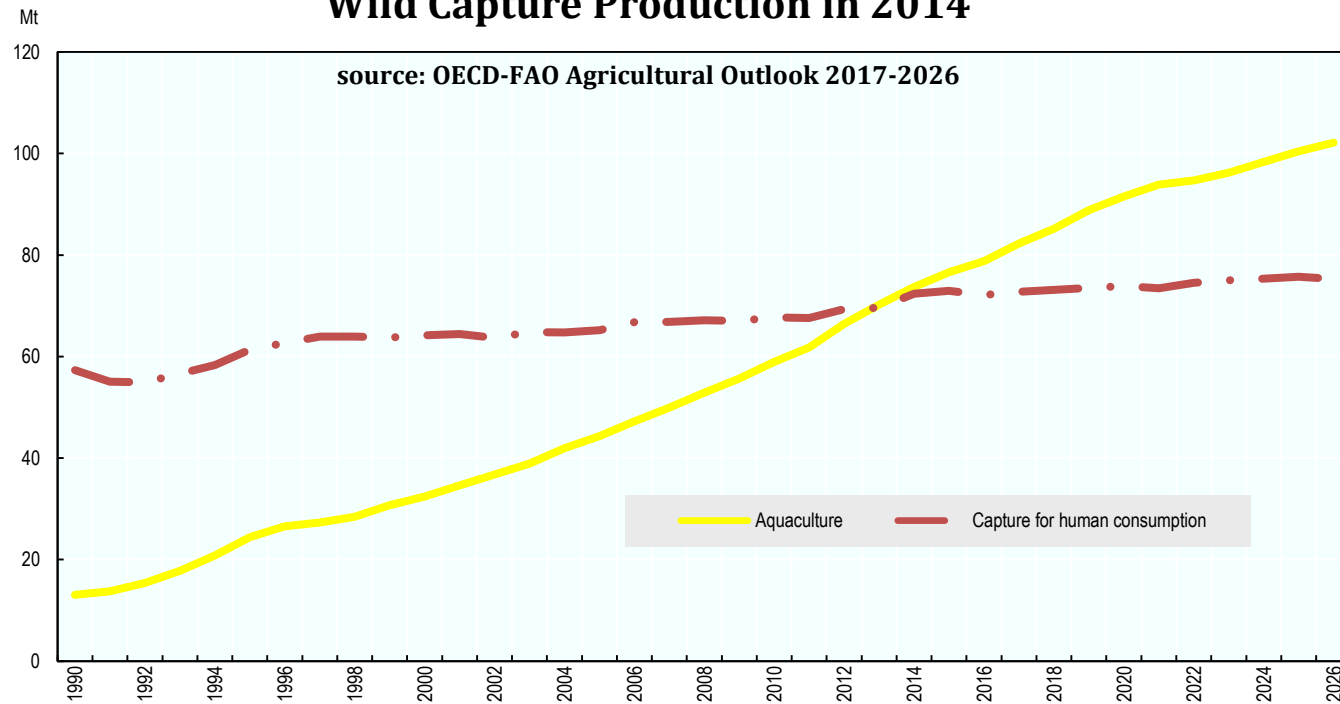


## Global Aquaculture Production Exceeded Wild Capture Production in 2014



- The global consumption of fish per capita has doubled from 10 kg per year to 20 kg per year over the past 50 years, even as global population has increased dramatically.
- Wild fisheries do not have the capacity to support the increasing demand for seafood and any future growth of seafood consumption will have to be supplied by industrial scale aquaculture.
- **Hawaii's competitive advantages: abundant natural resources, sophisticated infrastructure and expertise in the public and private sectors, political stability, geographic isolation for biosecurity and geographic placement between the two largest seafood importers, Asia and North America.**
